To this end, we shall:

- Strive to work jointly with our customers and supply chain partners to comply with all legal, statutory, regulatory and contractual requirements with respect to Conflict Minerals and exercise due diligence with our vendors and suppliers
- Ensure that the products and materials we procure do not contain Conflict Minerals sourced from conflict mines located in Covered Countries
- Maintain transparency in implementing this policy by sharing all relevant information with the concerned stakeholders
